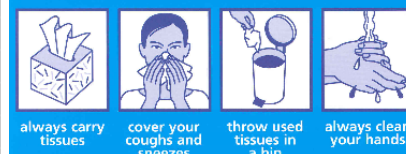

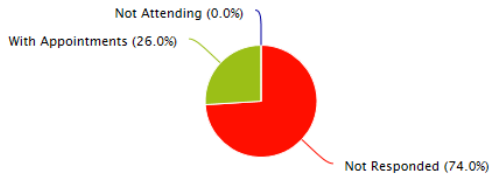
## Parents Evening.
