It's good to be back!

Dear Parents & Carers,

It has been a real pleasure to stand on the playground and welcome our children back to Holbrook this week, seeing them appreciate all the hard work that all the staff have put in place to make sure that school is safe for their return. It has been lovely to see pupils from Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 6 back in the classroom with their teachers.

I am sure from talking to your children on the way home from school, that they have told you about the changes to the school day to keep everyone safe.

Lots of furniture and resources have been removed from

classrooms, desks are spread apart (a bit like when we do tests) and there are only 8 desk spaces! This all means that it is easier to socially distance during the day and that the classrooms are easy to deep clean in the evening. In fact since we have returned, the children will have noticed our team of cleaners who pop into classes and corridors during the day to clean down desks, chairs and door handles, in fact, any surface that pupils might have touched, to keep everywhere clean and as safe as

The feedback from the teachers is that the children have really enjoyed their day back in school. To ensure we maintain social distancing, I have not been in classrooms, but have stood outside classrooms to say hello to everyone! It is important that we restrict the number of adults into classroom areas to ensure that we keep these protective bubbles safe. As a team, we are constantly assessing if there is anything else we can do to make things even better and safer for our pupils.

As we are so happy with how things have gone this week, we are preparing plans to reopen the school for more year groups over the next few weeks! Again, it will only be small groups of around 8 children in each class and their start and end time will be different so that we can maintain social distancing for all on the school site but means that all children should get the opportunity to return to school before we break up for the Summer. Staff have worked hard to make sure that all siblings are invited into school on the same day. Look out for your text message with the link to your letter telling you about



your child's return.

Not everyone who had the chance to come into the school has taken up the offer, but as you see the procedures we have in place and chat to other parents hopefully you will start to feel more confident about sending your child. When you are comfortable about sending them in please do so on the right day! We all look forward to seeing them. Don't worry if you have forgotten which day they should be in, you will get sent a text message reminder the night before.
