I am very excited to announce that we have a new school APP that links to our current e-mail / text messaging system—School Gateway. As well as messages from the school



In the morning the inner gates are opened from 8:25 and classroom doors from 8:30. This means there is a 15 minute window for pupils to come into school as we start taking the registers at 8:45.

At the end of the day the gates are opened from 2:50pm for pupils to be collected from that time onwards. Pupils walking home alone will be let out at 3pm.

This longer drop off and collection times mean that we have a minimal number of parents congregating on the playground helping keep our wider school community safe but we do need to start securing the playground gates at 8:45am and 3:10pm.

Secondary School Applications

The deadline for all applications is

31 October 2020.

From the <u>Secondary Booklet</u> 'Last year 78.6% of children got their first preference school due to the high number of applicants. Many schools received more applications than there are places available. This meant that parents who applied late were often unsuccessful in getting a place at one of their preferred schools. It is therefore very important that you apply by the closing date and use the information in this booklet and advice from Admissions staff to ensure you have the best chance of getting a place at your preferred school.'

Please make sure you look at the booklet and the guide for <u>School Admissions Online User Guide</u> so that you can make sure you get your applications in on time.

PE Kits.

A huge THANK YOU to all the parents and carers who are sending their children in correct PE kit on the right day.
