You must complete 6 of the activities.



Use a map of the world to locate the physical and human features of a state in America.

Create a quiz about the Mayans and Aztec.

Write a newspaper article about the discovery of North America.

Create a campaign for you to become President. You could make a poster, write a manifesto or write a speech.

Write a diary entry from the perspective of one of the first explorers of America.

Create a recipe for a healthy burger.

Make a 3D model of a famous statue or building in North America.

Write an advert to persuade someone to buy your healthy burger.

Write a biography about Harriet Tubman, Nat Turner, Benjamin Franklin or Harriet Beecher-Stowe.

Research information about the first explorers to America.

Plot a graph to show how long each President has governed the USA.

Create a leaflet for a travel brochure persuading someone to visit North America.

Write a set of instructions about how to make a tepee.

Draw a map of a state or country in North America.
