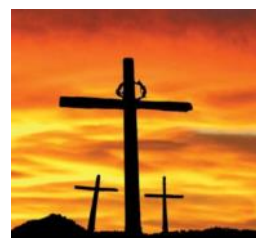


We have recently shared booklets detailing PSHE lessons for the summer term. If you would like more information about this please join us for our parent workshops on the following dates:

As we move into summer please make sure your child comes with a **full** water bottle. If they do drink it all it can always be refilled.



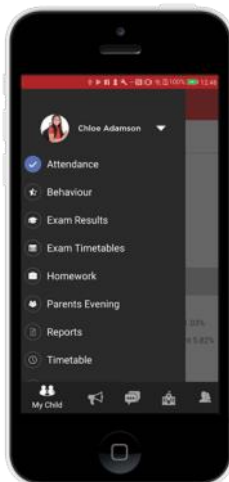
Extracurricular Clubs
