Well done to everyone for representing the school so well. You were amazing!




### **Shoe Laces!**

may be a better option.




There is a good rhyme on YouTube and with some card and lace (Different colours help!) you can practise at home.

# Fasting during Ramadan.

At Holbrook School we are very happy to support our pupils and families during Ramadan. If you wish your child to fast for part or all of the month of Ramadan you need to inform us. An online form has been sent out to all parents of children in Year 4-6 to complete if they wish their child to fast.

If the school has not received a permission slip from you, stating that your child is fasting, as a school we are responsible for your child's well-being and we will encourage them to eat their lunch as normal.

According to guidelines for those choosing to fast (Muslim Council of Britain), students will be expected to take part in a normal daily routine.


Therefore, they will be expected to take part in a full school curriculum, including PE. For Health and Safety reasons, those students who are fasting will be advised to take part in PE lessons at a lower level of impact.


In the event of very hot or very sunny weather we will use shaded areas on the playing fields. We will encourage children to remain seated between any activities in order to conserve their energy.

Children must listen carefully to and to follow the teacher's instructions and advice.

In event of a fasting student becoming unwell, the school may consider providing them with something to eat or drink, unless their parent has informed us in advance that they do not wish this to happen.
