Challenge 18... Card games



From Top Trumps, Uno or a cheap pack of playing cards there is lots of fun and learning to be applied.

If you have one pack of cards a perfect game for everyone from Reception to 99 years old is:-

Higher, Lower, Same.

- Remove the jokers and shuffle the cards well.
- Turn over the top card.
- First person has to guess if the next card will be higher, lower or the same. Aces are both... so you can never be wrong!
- Wrong - both cards go to the bottom of the pack—so try and remember why you went wrong as the cards will come back.
- If the guess was correct you have two choices—Stick and keep the card or guess again from that card.
- If you stick or get it wrong it is the next persons go.
- The person with the most cards at the end is the winner.
