Thank you for your lovely comments and messages of congratulations following the publication of our Ofsted report. I wanted to take this opportunity to share some information about the one recommendation inspectors made:

'There are too few high-quality opportunities for pupils to develop their writing across the curriculum. As a result, some pupils do not always produce writing which reflects and extends their writing ability well enough, and which demonstrates their depth of subject knowledge. The school should ensure that there are regular opportunities for pupils to practise, extend, and develop their writing ability across the whole curriculum so that all pupils consistently develop their writing ability.'

Staff had already been looking at this throughout the spring term, and we have started to review our writing curriculum so this is a very helpful. Our next steps will be as follows:

- 1) Complete our ongoing review of the way we currently teaching writing, and make any necessary improvements to the design of the curriculum and the structure of lessons.
- 2) Look at opportunities for children to write in other lessons such as History, Geography and Science.
- 3) Provide training for staff so that everyone can deliver any changes skilfully and confidently.
- 4) Raise the profile of Writing with children, including the core skills of handwriting, spelling and grammar.
