Indoor Shoes.

We ask that all pupils take off outdoor shoes when they come in to school and change into a pair suitable for the indoors.

We do this as pupils are expected to sit on carpets and the hall during many parts of the lesson and we want the floors to be nice and clean. At home you take off your shoes rather than walk dirt into the house. Also we want to spend the school budget on resources to support your child's learning, not deep cleaning or replacing carpets.

The reason we ask for an indoor pair of shoes is that if we have a fire evacuation we need to leave school straight away—no stopping to put on footwear!
